## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTION

**WARNING**

These instructions should be carefully read before installation. The booklet must be kept and delivered to the next user. The Manufacturer reserves the right to vary the features of the product without prior notice. The technical data are indicative only.

- THIS APPLIANCE IS HOT WHEN OPERATED AND CAN CAUSE SEVERE BURNS IF TOUCHED.**
- Do not operate appliance before reading and understanding instructions. Failure to operate appliance could cause fire or injury.
- Keep this product away from combustible materials at least 3 feet (0.9 m), such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes and curtains at least 3 feet (0.9 m). **WARNING:** In order to avoid overheating, do not cover the heater. The space may be inadequate when installed in a flammable vehicle.
- Risk of burns. Please do not touch the appliance directly after use and cooling for a while. Please turn off the control and then remove plug if you want disconnect power of appliance.
- Do not install damaged or incompatible components.
- Young children should be carefully supervised when they are in the same room with the appliance. They may be susceptible to accidental contact burns.
- Do not install damaged, incompatible or substitute components.
- To prevent accidental swallowing, small parts should be kept away from children and infants.
- There is a small battery in the remote. Please keep away from children.
- Do not install battery in the wrong direction, put a piece of tape or fix it with other type of battery.
- Ensure you have adequate safety measures to protect infants/children from burning hot surfaces.
- It is imperative that the control components, including heater and ventilation channels in the appliance are kept clean. The appliance should be inspected before use and operated by a qualified service person once a year.
- Under no circumstances should this appliance be modified.
- Do not use this appliance if any part has been in contact with water. Please call a qualified service technician to inspect the appliance immediately and to replace the parts which has been in contact with water.
- Do not operate the appliance when the glass door was removed, cracked or broken. Replacement of the glass service should be done by a qualified service person.
- Do not enter the glass door of appliance.
- Keep the packaging material away from children and dispose of the materials in a safe manner.

## SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

15. Always unplug appliance when not in use.

16. Do not operate this appliance with a damaged cord or plug after the appliance malfunctions, please return appliance to authorized service facility for electrical or mechanical adjustment, or repair.

17. Do not use appliance outdoors.

18. Never place appliance where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.

19. Do not run cord under carpet. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, furniture etc. Place cord away from cluttered area and where it will not be stepped over.

### 3.1 UNPACKING AND TESTING APPLIANCE WALL

Carefully remove the appliance from the box. Before installing the appliance, make sure the appliance operates properly by plugging the power supply cord into a conveniently located 120 Volt grounded outlet.

### 3.2 GROUNDING APPLIANCE

This appliance is for use on 120 Volts. The cord has a plug as shown in (A). An adapter as shown in (B) is available for connecting three-hole grounding-type plugs to two-hole receptacles. The ground type plug, extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box. The adapter should not be used if a three-hole grounded receptacle is available. To disconnect the appliance, turn the controls off, then remove the plug from the outlet.

### 3.2 GROUNDING APPLIANCE

This appliance is for use on 120 Volts. The cord has a plug as shown in (A). An adapter as shown in (B) is available for connecting three-hole grounding-type plugs to two-hole receptacles. The ground type plug, extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box. The adapter should not be used if a three-hole grounded receptacle is available. To disconnect the appliance, turn the controls off, then remove the plug from the outlet.

## 4.0 FINISHING

## 5.0 OPERATING INSTRUCTION

Once the appliance has been plugged into a grounded electrical outlet, it is ready to operate.

## Installation - Built in Construction

### Step 1: Removing the Glass Frame

The fireplace can be installed with 2 options:

- Remove the fixed screen in the side panel.
- Lift the glass frame 1.2 cm vertically. Then the entire glass frame can be removed from the front.

Take the glass frame 10-20 cm away from the appliance, pull out the data cable connector with the help of others or put the glass panel down on the ground before complete separation.

### Step 2: Setting the Holes of Screw

The appropriate cavity (1.2 cm bigger for each side) needs to be prepared according to the size of the appliance.

Put the fireplace in place, mark the holes which need to be drilled with a pencil. Then take it out of the cavity again.

### Step 3: Drilling & Installing the Wall Anchors

Drill the holes (12 to 17 mm) on the prepared marks.

Insert the wall anchors (Part C) into the holes by using a hammer.

### Step 4: Placing the Pads and Fixing the Fireplace

Screws (Part A) pass through the holes from the front of fireplace with screwdriver.

Mount the fireplace and push back the screws (Part B) until the fireplace is fixed.

Put the fireplace into the prepared cavity.

Fasten the fireplace firmly into the wall by the screws for each side.

### Step 5: Placing the Decorations

Carefully place crystal (together with the appliance) or other decoration into the bottom tray on the front of the appliance as illustrated.

**NOTE:** Media bed kits may have sharp edges, wear safety goggles and gloves when handling.

### Step 6: Hanging the Glass Frame

Connect the data cable connector before hanging the glass frame on the appliance.

Insert the glass frame into the cavity and push back the screws (Part B) until the glass frame is fixed.

### Step 7: Refasten the Glass Frame

Insert the screws (Part C) into the drilled holes on the glass panel. Check the alignment of the glass panel and securely tighten the screws.

## 4.0 FINISHING

## 5.1 CONTROL PANEL / REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION

The touch display panel is shown on the up right of the front of the appliance.

**Before use, open the back cover of the remote control and put in the AAA battery**

POWER	1	Turn the appliance ON/OFF. NOTE: Make sure the main switch on the top of fireplace is turned on before operating.
DIMMER	2	Control Flame brightness. Setting 5 (1.4, 2.3, 3.4, 4.5) Flame dims from L1 to L5. L5 is the brightest setting.
TIMER	3	Control the Timer. 8 Settings (1h, 2h, 3h, 4h, 5h, 6h, 7h, 8h) Press button until reach desired setting.
FLAME SPEED	4	Control Flame speed. 8 Settings (V1-V2-V3-V4-V5) Flame speed from V1 to V5. V5 is the highest setting.

HEATER	1	Control the Heater. Press button to adjust the heater. (OFF) no heater or slower. (1) Heater flames warm (750 W) (2) Heater flames hot (1500 W) NOTE: Heater functions cycle from (OFF) (1)-(2).
COLOR	2	Flame and carbon color change simultaneously. Set 12 colors as follows: 1. Blue 2. Yellow 3. Blue 4. Orange 5. Red 6. Yellow 7. Blue 8. Blue 9. Yellow 10. Blue 11. Blue 12. Yellow 13.
