

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS SSWH30

STAINLESS STEEL RECIRCULATING CLEANER

FOR USE WITH AQUEOUS CLEANING SYSTEMS

SET-UP AND OPERATION

Unpack the parts washer and inspect for any visible signs of damage during shipping. If damage Has occurred, please contact the distributor where the unit was purchased for proper instructions.

| STEP 1) | Choose a suitable location for the SSWH30MOD series parts washer and place a 30 gallon drum. | | | |
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| STEP 2) | Place the DHR900 heater in the drum with the heater box located on the right side of the drum. | | | |
| STEP 3) | Fill the drum with the aqueous cleaning solution of choice. | | | |
| STEP 4) | Place the parts washer on its front; insert pump on the pump hanger into bracket located on the bottom of the tub. | | | |
| STEP 5) | Carefully place tub on top of the drum which should be full of cleaning solution. | | | |
| STEP 6) | Align the Tub with the Drum Heater so the Heater passes through the gap in the Mounting Ring on the bottom of the Tub | | | |
| STEP 7) | Plug the pump power cord into the upper receptacle (switched outlet). Plug the heater into the bottom receptacle (outlet not switched). Plug the electrical assembly power cord into a properly grounded outlet with 115V/60Hz, 15 Amp power source. | | | |
| STEP 8) | Set the adjustable thermostat on the heater to the desired temperature. Allow 2-3 hours for the cleaning solution to heat up. | | | |
| STEP (9) | Switch power to the Aon@ position. Cleaning solution should be at a stead flow through the flex hose and flow thru cleaning brush. The parts washer is now ready for use. | | | |
| STEP (10) | TURN OF THE UNIT WHEN NOT IN USE. LEAVING THIS UNIT RUNNING MAY RESULT IN PREMATURE FAILURE OF THE DRUM HEATER OR PUMP. FAILURE OF THE PUMP OR HEATER CAUSED BY RUNNING THESE ITEMS IN A DRY ENVIRONMENT WILL VOID THE WARPANTY | | | |
