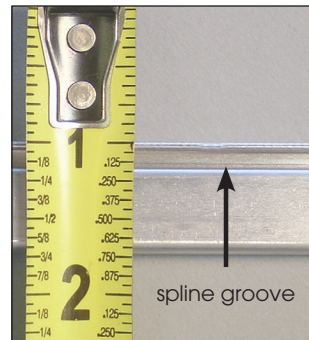




SELECTING THE RIGHT SPLINE FOR YOUR SCREEN FRAME

- Measure the spline groove on your screen frame. Spline grooves vary on different screen frame.
- The spline size should match the spline groove width for standard insect screen, as a point of reference.
- Screens like PetScreen® and SunTex® will require a smaller diameter spline because of the fabric thickness.
