Powder Coating vs. Wet Paint

The advantages of using powder coating over wet paint are many. Most importantly powder coatings are more durable and more resistant to corrosion, chemicals and weather than liquid coatings. The bright and fresh coating is more resistant to chipping, scratching and general wear under heavy use. This is due to the thermal bonding which occurs during the curing process in the oven. Additionally because powder coatings contain no solvents or harmful VOC's, they are the more environmentally friendly than their wet paint associates. Powder Coatings meet all Environmental Protection Agency requirements for air and water pollution control.
