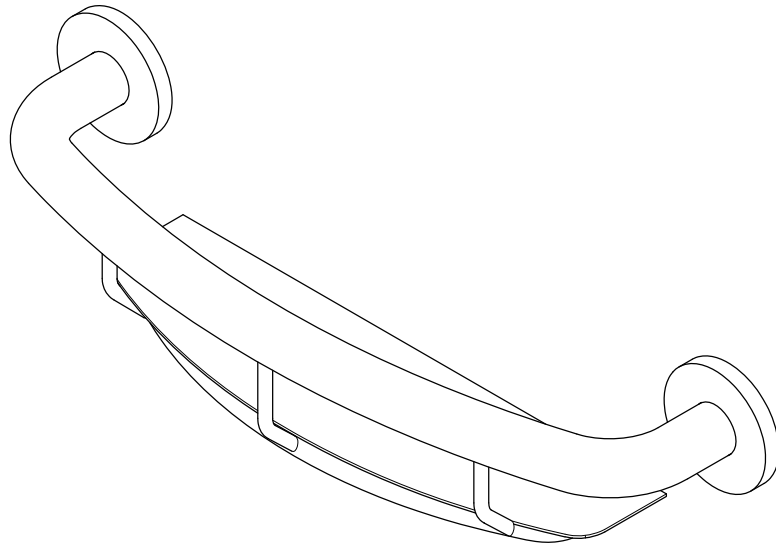


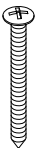


Grab Bar Shelf Installation Instructions

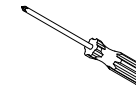

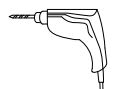
Tools Required



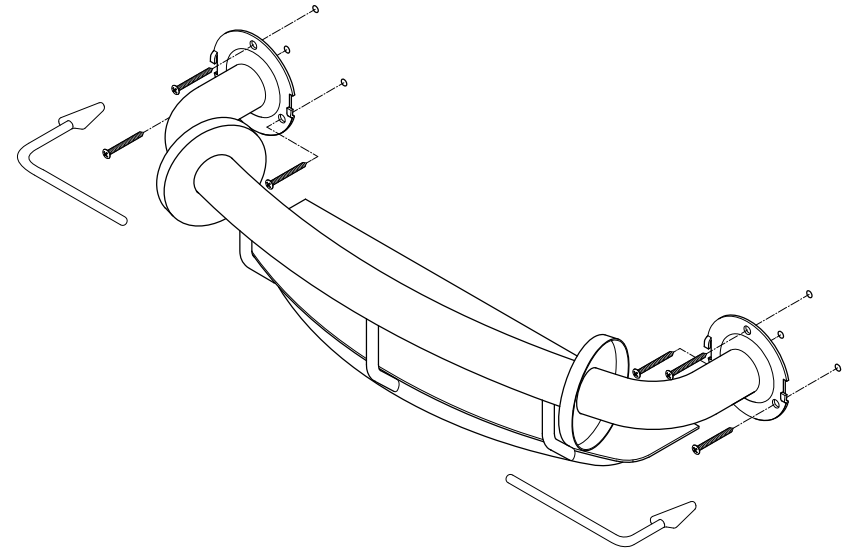
Marking Pencil



Phillips Screwdriver



Power Drill



Before you begin your installation:

1. A grab bar is as good as the way it's installed.
2. Make sure to confirm that there is proper wood backing at both points of attachment for this grab bar.
3. If there is no wood backing available at both points, attach a 2" x 6" minimum piece of lumber between the studs.
4. If a proper wood bracing is not available, consult your contractor as to the best anchors to use for your specific application some options available are Tile/masonry anchors, toggle bolts, plastic anchors, metal anchors and drywall anchors.
5. Maximum weight capacity is 300 LBS.

Installation Steps:

1. Place bar at the desired location. Level and mark the location of the holes.
2. Remove bar and drill starter holes (5/64").
3. Mount grab bar to the wall using 2" screws, or the appropriate anchors for your specific wall type.
4. Press flanges to the base and turn clockwise to lock in place.

Cleaning

Clean with a damp cloth only.
Avoid using metal or abrasive polishes.

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
